**Resolution WG 3/10:**

WG 3 resolves that SC 32 request JTC 1 to:

1. Make permanent the policy that permits normative references to specifications other than International Standards in JTC 1 International Standards.
2. Ensure that the permanent policy permitting such references distinguishes between recognized publicly-available specifications (such as those developed and published by organizations having specific liaison relationships with JTC 1 or one of its Subcommittees) and those specifications that are not as readily visible or available.
3. Relax the requirements associated with Referencing Explanatory Reports for Referenced Specifications that are such recognized publicly-available specifications so that the requirements are less demanding than specified in JTC 1 N 4046.
4. Publish a list of such recognized publicly-available specifications for which no

Referencing Explanatory Report is required, and maintain that list for easy reference by JTC 1's Subcommittees.
