Important Information Requirement for Abstracts when submitting FDIS

As of 2002-05-01, it is required to provide an abstract when submitting a draft standard to ITTF for **FDIS ballot and/or publication**. Note, however, that it is not necessary to provide abstracts for standards which are to be published as common text with ITU-T, as the ITU summary will be used for that purpose.
