Liaison Report on OMG & SC32

(A Liaison Between SC32 and OMG)

1. Special Meeting with OMG at San Diego,

March 26th ~ 30th, Some of SC32 members (Bruce Bargmeyer, Masao Okabe and Hajime Horiuchi) participated to the San Diego TC meeting and made presentations on the current status of SC32WG2 activities at the ADTF meeting and at a liaison meeting. Also a special meeting was held with Ontology-PSIG members to confirm the current status and the future possibility of collaboration between OMG and SC32.

2. Confirmation status of PAS on CWM

The preparation of a PAS submission for the current version of Common Warehouse Metamodel (CWM) is complete. It is expected that this will be sent to JTC1 with SC 32 named as the responsible JTC 1 Subcommittee. We note that OMG has initiated work on a the Information Management Metamodel (IMM) which will take over current CWM. SC32 should notify JTC 1 that SC 32/WG 2 is willing to take on the editing role for CWM.

3. Possibility of ODM PAS submission

At the special meeting with Ontology-PSIG, it was agreed that OMG would prepare a PAS submission for the Ontology Definition Metamodel (ODM). That will be done after ODM is finalized in OMG; expected date will be the end of 2007. SC32 should notify JTC 1 that SC 32/WG 2 is willing to take on the editing role for ODM.

Possibility of other OMG standards,

In future, following OMG standards should be investigated for invitation as OMG PAS submissions for ISO/IEC standardization:

- IMM (Information Management Metamodel)
- MOF2.0 (as Replace of ISO/IEC19502)
- XMI2.0 (as Replace of ISO/IEC19503)
- QVT (Query View Transformation)
