Canadian Comments on SC32 1836B Letter Ballot

1. The title of the study period does not accurately reflect the proposed scope. Change the Study Period name to:
'Study Period on the Future Direction, Harmonization and possible Integration of the 11179 and 19763 families of standards and related standards'
2. Note that 'integration' does not necessarily mean 'consolidation'.
3. Note that 19763 already uses Administered_Item from 11179-3 edition 2, and should be enhanced to use Registered_Item from 11179-3 edition 3 when the new edition is published.
4. Note that 19763 has an AWI on Registration Process, but 11179-6 already describes a registration process. 11179-6 should be extended to support the needs of 19763, rather than duplicating the process, as proposed in item 4 of the proposed study period scope.
5. 19763-5 describes a process model which could be readily registered directly using 11179-3 edition 3, for those users who do not need the functionality of 19763-2. (See ballot comments on CD 19763-5.) It may be possible to do the same for other parts, e.g. the proposed part 7.
