Rationale Summary:

In 2005, SC32 approved this WG3 project to generate Type 3 technical reports about various aspects of the SQL standard. For the WG3 interim meeting in December, 2005, Fred Zemke of the USA wrote a paper expanding the regular expression support in SQL/Foundation, which was published in the 2008 SQL/Foundation IS (9075-2:2008). The discussion section of this paper contained a large number of examples of using the regular expression capabilities. While this information is not appropriate for the standard itself, it is useful for both users and implementers of the standard. Therefore, we have extracted this discussion section and created this Type 3 Technical Report.
