- 5) Rooms and rates:  
Rooms are available at the US Government rate of \$150 USD for single occupancy and \$180 USD for double occupancy. The hotel is holding 25 rooms under the group name SC32WG2. Please use this name when making your reservation. The rooms are available from 7 November through 13 November. The hotel will hold the rooms until 30 days before the meeting. They will release the rooms on 7 October. Please make your reservations early.
- 6) Orientation and directions from hotel to meeting facility
  - The Phoenix Park hotel is on the SW corner of North Capitol St and Massachusetts Ave
  - The Bureau of Labor Statistics is in the building on the NE corner of North Capitol St and Massachusetts Ave
  - From the Phoenix Park hotel
    - Turn left (north) after leaving the front door
    - Cross Massachusetts Ave (the wide street)
    - Once across Massachusetts Ave, turn right (east) to cross North Capitol St
    - Walk up the hill to 1st St NE (The BLS building is on your left as you walk up the hill)
    - At the top of the hill, turn left (north) and walk down the hill to the Bureau of Labor Statistics Visitors Entrance
    - Present your passport to the guards. They will have a list of all participants.
    - Pass through the metal detector and x-ray machines, then go straight through the glass doors

Turn left and take the elevator down one floor to the G level  
Follow the signs to the Conference Center and Room #7

7) Access to Metro (subway) and taxis

Union Station at 1st St and Massachusetts Ave NE

8) Restaurants

Union Station has a food court on the bottom floor and many restaurants on the main floor

Dubliner and The Irish Times are right next to the hotel

The Capitol City Brew Club is in the same building as BLS

There are many other restaurants in the area within walking distance

9) Tourist Attractions

The US Capitol, the Supreme Court, the Library of Congress, the Smithsonian Museums are all within walking distance of the hotel

The White House and the Memorials (Washington, Lincoln, Jefferson, Franklin, and various wars) are a little farther away
