ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 32 CD 13249-1, 3, 6 San Francisco Editing Meeting Resolution

Eleven experts representing five National Bodies (Canada, Germany, Japan, UK, and US) are participating the editing meeting.

For Part 1: Framework, 11 CD ballot comments including 2 Major Technical, 3 Minor Technical, 1 Major Editorial, and 5 Minor Editorial, have all been successfully resolved except 1 comment.

For Part 3: Spatial, 43 CD ballot comments including 24 Major Technical, 12 Minor Technical, 5 Major Editorial, and 2 Minor Editorial, have all been successfully resolved except 3 comments.

For Part 6: Data Mining, 91 CD ballot comments including 11 Major Technical, 31 Minor Technical, 19 Major Editorial, and 30 Minor Editorial, have all been successfully resolved except 10 comments.

In total, the editing meeting process 145 comments, and resolved 131 comments. 14 comments are still open.
