## **ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 32 FCD 13249-1, 3, and 6 Wellington Editing Meeting Resolution**

Six National Bodies (Australia, Canada, Germany, Japan, UK, and US) and fourteen experts are participating the meeting.

For Part 1: Framework, among 53 FCD ballot comments (including 1 Major Technical, 13 Minor Technical, 13 Major Editorial, and 23 Minor Editorial,) most comments have been successfully resolved. However, some comments are deferred.

For Part 3: Spatial, among 286 FCD ballot comments (including 38 Major Technical, 200 Minor Technical, 44 Major Editorial, and 4 Minor Editorial,) 80% of comments have been successfully resolved. However, some Major Technical comments have not been resolved.

For Part 6: Data Mining, among 22 FCD ballot comments (including 2 Major Technical, 0 Minor Technical, 13 Major Editorial, and 7 Minor Editorial,) have all been successfully resolved except one comment.

### **Resolution MM 1. Continuation Editing Meeting for FCD 1, 3, and 6**

Editing Group recommends a continuation editing meeting for FCD 1, 3, and 6 at the forthcoming SC 32 meeting in Kobe, Japan, in March 2006.
